Recycl-IN rPP1025 is a high rigidity polypropylene homopolymer intended for injection-moulding applications (thin-walled injection). This grade contains 50 % of post-consumer recycled material, natural colour.

This grade is not suitable for food packaging or pharma/medical applications

Storage
