HDPE 55060 is a semi high molecular weight (SHMW) high density polyethylene (HDPE) with outstanding Environmental Stress Cracking Resistance (ESCR) and rigidity. It has been specifically designed for the manufacture of blow moulded articles (open top drums and jerry-cans) dedicated for the transportation of dangerous goods. This product is also suitable for food contact application.

HDPE 55060 is a pellet grade and contains antioxidants.
